- Traditions and/or celebrations
- Values: what is important in your family (religion, education, sports, travel, ???)

This project is an opportunity to “double dip” (meaning you can get credit for a scrapbook page as well!). Projects can be done on paper or digitally (programs to try: PowerPoint, canva, piktochart, Word, other? – if digital, post to edublog).

EDUBLOG REQUIREMENTS:

- a) Add your visual and written component to the post
- b) Title – My Family
- c) Category – FS 11
- d) Tag – FS11LazarMyFamily
- e) Click Publish



CONTENT:

- You must be the central figure in your presentation
- The strength of your relationship to others will be conveyed by the closeness and/or size in relation to you
- May be presented in the form of a mind map or other graphic organizer
- Use photos, drawings, or other graphics to convey information; text should be kept to a typical scrapbook entry of 4-5 sentences (can be in paragraph form or split)
- The visual representation must be eye catching, colourful, neat and easy to read

- Traditions, values, celebrations included
- Neat, eye catching, colourful
- Multiple images included
- Concise explanations included
