*I only have a broken back*



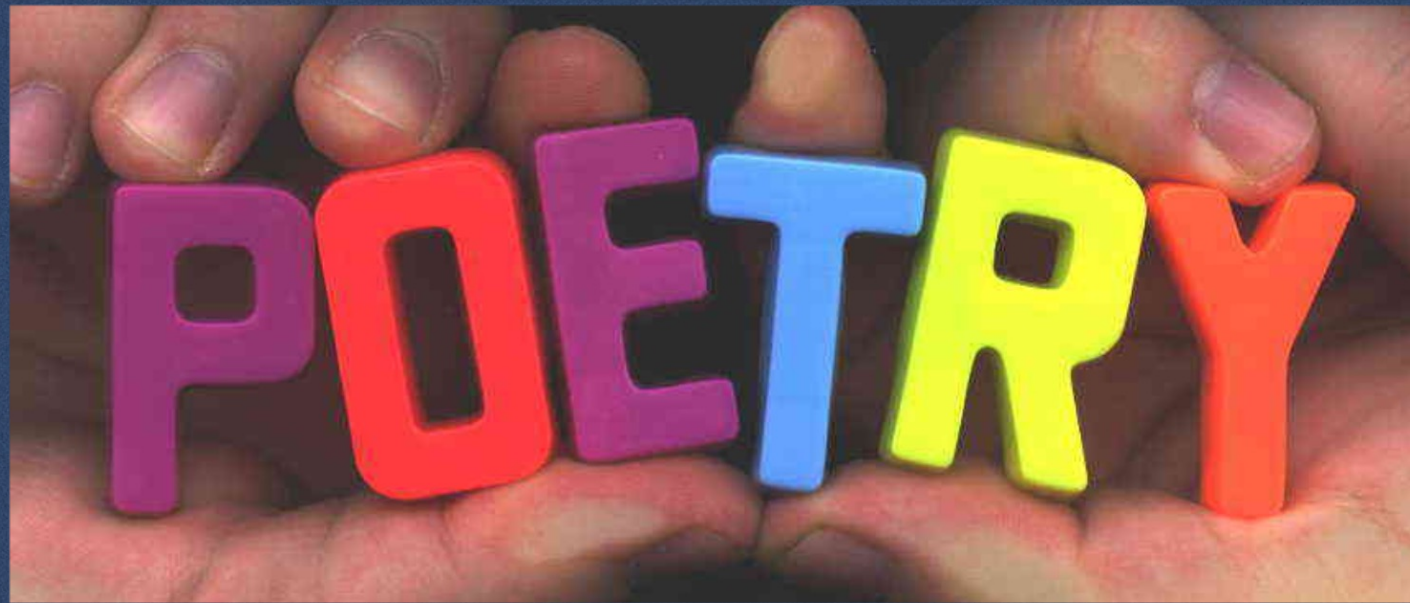
# Repetition
