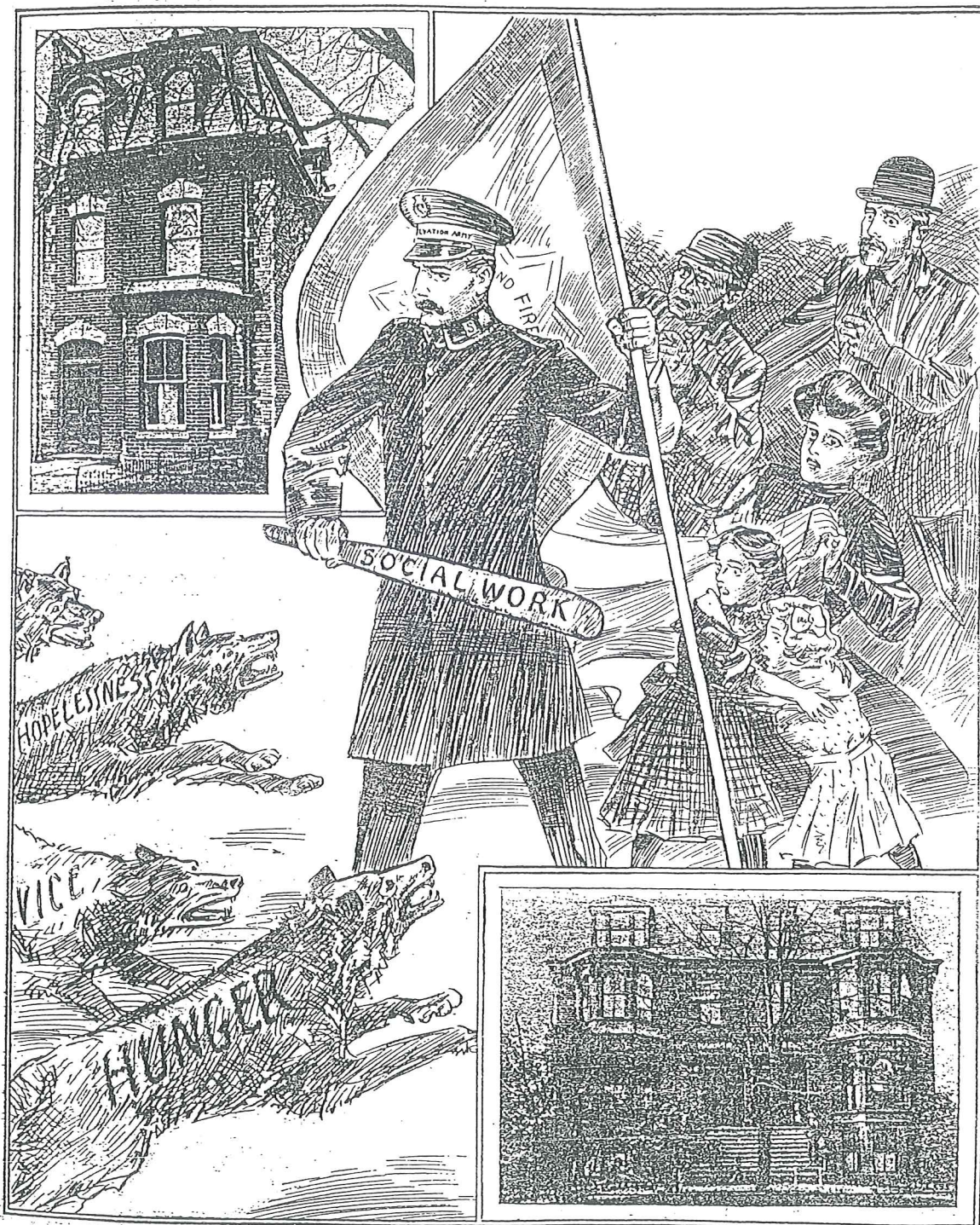

SCHOOL ATTENDANCE CONTINUES TO GROW.

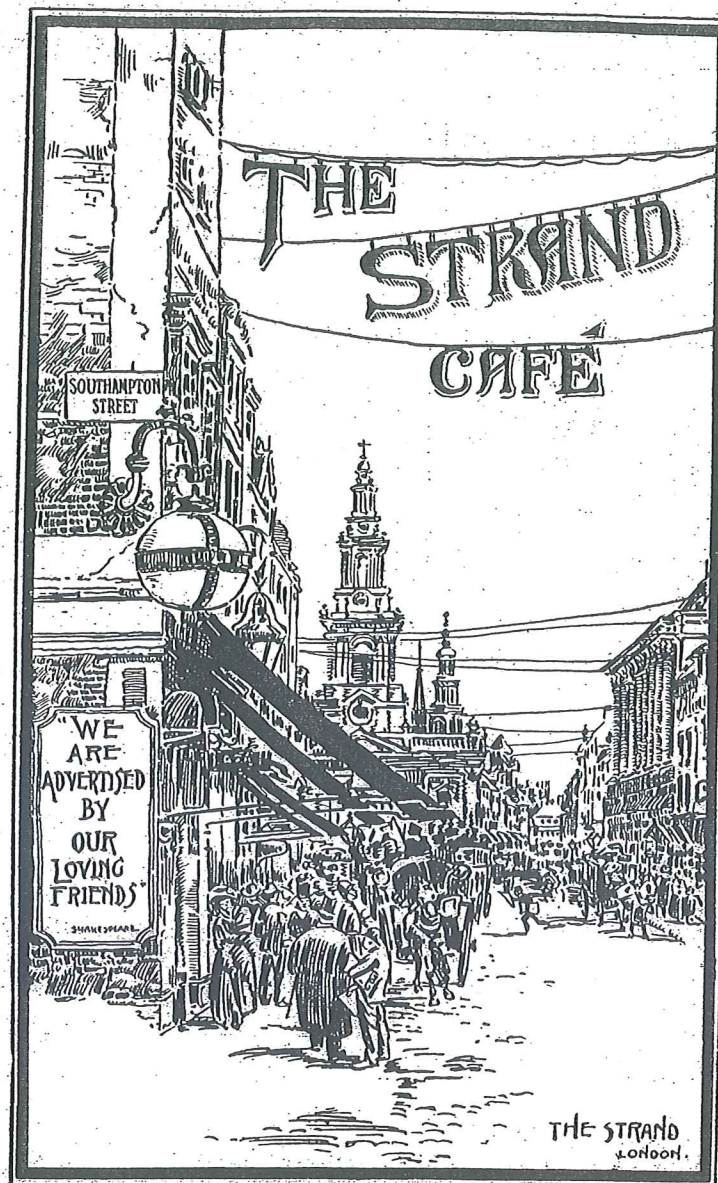
Figures Show an Increase of Fifty in

The school population of Vancouver continues to increase. The statistics for the past month show an increase of over 50 in the number in attendance at the City schools. 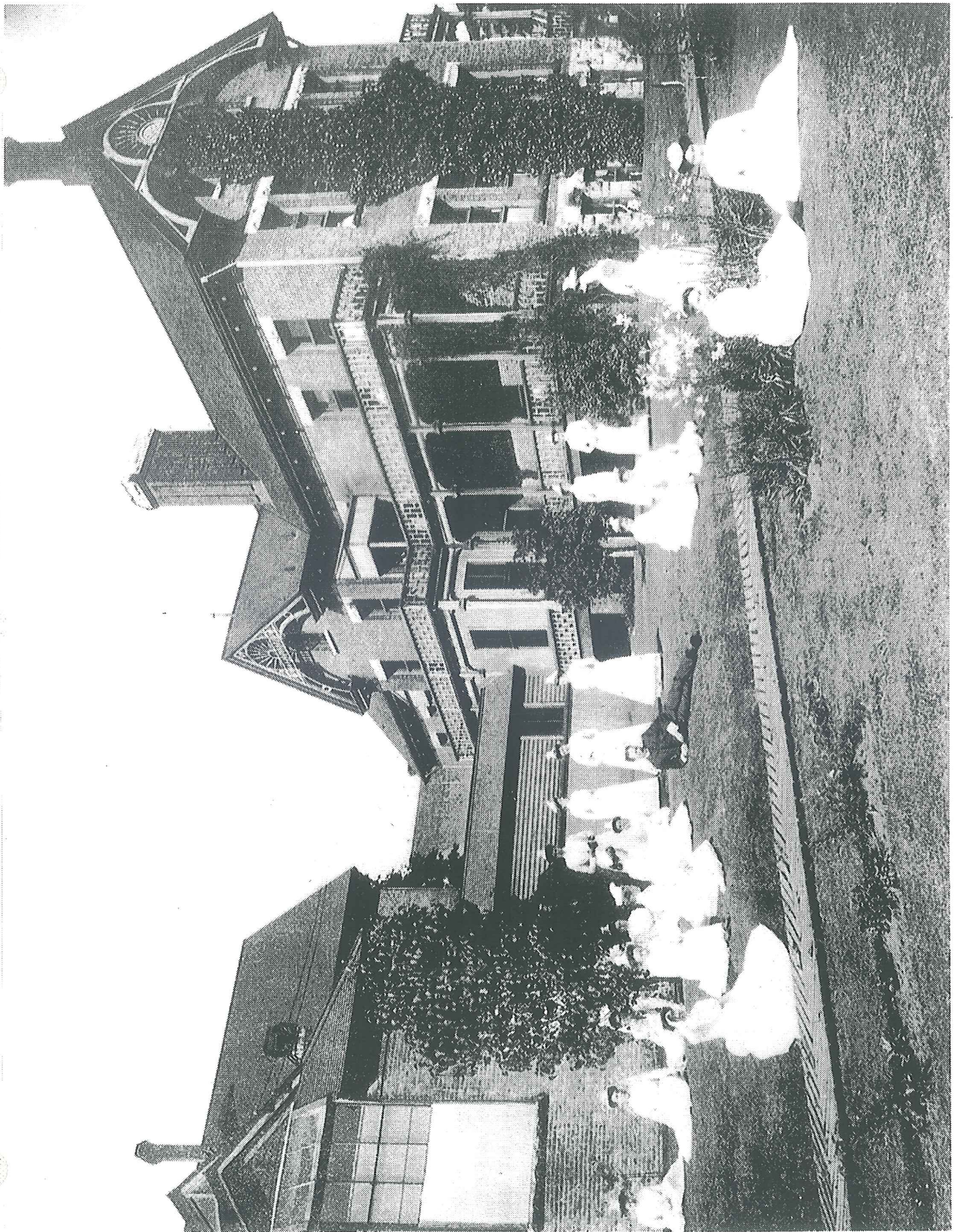
