5. Search the internet for keyboarding related websites: informational, typing practice, speed tests, games, etc. List your top three choices, provide the url and write a review for each one outlining how it helps improve keyboarding and what you like about it (minimum 100 words each). (6 marks)
6. Discuss the terms 'QWERTY' and 'ergonomic keyboard'. What is it? Where did it come from? What is their significance in keyboarding? (4 marks)
7. List 10 words (with at least 6 letters each) that can be typed using only the right hand. List 10 words (with at least 6 letters each) that can be typed using only the left hand. With which hand can you type more words? (10 marks)
