

Innovation Final Post

Now that you have shared your innovation with the Riverside Dragon’s Den, you will create a final post reflecting on the work that you and your group did and the learning that took place.

Instructions

Create a post on Edublogs that includes:

- 1) **Media** – Share a picture or video clip of your innovation presentation to the Rside Dragons (only include faces if your group agrees)
- 2) **Core Competency** – Share the description of evidence you used as you evaluated yourself on the Core Competency on which you choose to focus
- 3) **Collaboration reflection** - Reflect on the quality of the collaboration (see the rubric below)
- 4) **Experience Debrief** – What did you like about this endeavour? What would you do differently? What did you learn during the process?

Place the Post in your Science 9 and Self Assessment categories. Tag it ADL16Collaboration and the particular Core Competency you chose:
