#### "Artifact" from the Great War

Your task is to create an "artifact" from this important time period in Canadian history. **<u>Utilize the knowledge you have learned</u>** about the causes of WWI, trench warfare, key battles, and contributions on the home front to help you create a realistic artifact.

Choose **one** of the following options:

### Option #1

Write 3 journal entries from the point of view of a Canadian soldier on the Western Front. Be sure to include what battle(s) you are fighting in, as well as share your feelings about living conditions, relationships with other soldiers, daily routines, and information about your health and diet. Don't forget to date the entries and create an identity!

### Option #2

Write 3 letters to your loved one(s) back home. Ideas to write about: what you have witnessed and experienced on the front lines, how much you have changed as a person as a result of these experiences, hopes for peace, how other men in your town are doing. You must date the letters, create identities for yourself and those you are writing to, and include addressed envelopes.

### Option #3

Using all the images and emotions you have witnessed and felt throughout this unit, create a song or poem about a specific part of the Great War that has struck a chord inside of you.

#### Option #4

Create a propaganda poster that encourages Canadians to enlist or support the war effort at home. Remember the time period you are creating this for! It can be created by hand or digitally.

# Option #5

Create a detailed model of trench warfare. Be sure to include labels and descriptors of all the elements (can be flagged on the model or you can create a key/legend).

## Option #6

Create a piece of art (traditional or digital) to represent trench warfare on the Western Front or an event on the home front.

If there is an artifact you would like to create that isn't listed above, please come and talk to me about your idea!
