Pre-Calculus 12 had enabled me to grow in the thinking competencies also because of the units that we went through during the year; as they became more challenging (the most challenging being trigonometry identities) it made me think more and made me try a different variety of ways in order to find the correct solutions and techniques in order for my learning to be effective for not only that unit but for future units as well. To prepare for my final exam, I intend on using similar strategies that I used for my first trigonometry test for (in which I got my highest mark for) and combining it with different strategies that my friends had used in order to achieve success within their tests as well. Although I'm not 100% confident going into the finals, the best thing that I can do for now is to keep consistent at studying and hope that I'll do well when the finals comes around. Studying for the finals will require a lot more effort compared to all of the other tests as it is a cumulative assessment of everything and so I plan on studying a lot more compared to my other tests. Also, because this is the first time in high school that I'm having a finals in Pre-Calculus I expect it to be more challenging compared to everything else I've done.
