Six years old when Scottsboro trials were meticulously covered in state and local newspapers

## Scout Finch's Childhood

Grew up in 1930s rural southern Alabama town

Father - Atticus Finch - attorney who served in state legislature in Alabama

Older brother and young neighbor (Dill) are playmates

Scout reads before she enters school; reads Mobile Register newspaper in first grade

Six years old when the trial of Tom Robinson takes place

## THE SETTING OF I.K.A.M.

-novel set in the fictitious town of Maycomb, Alabama

-takes place in the 1930's during The Great Depression.

-this was a time of massive poverty and hunger

-in 1931, more than 20,000 Americans committed suicide.

-by 1932, one quarter of the U.S.A.'s labour force was out of work.

-hourly wages dropped by 30%
