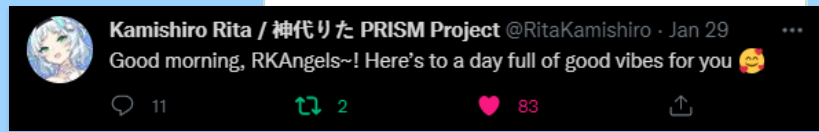

My Avatar



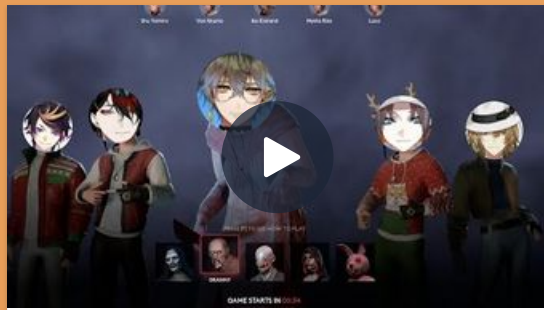

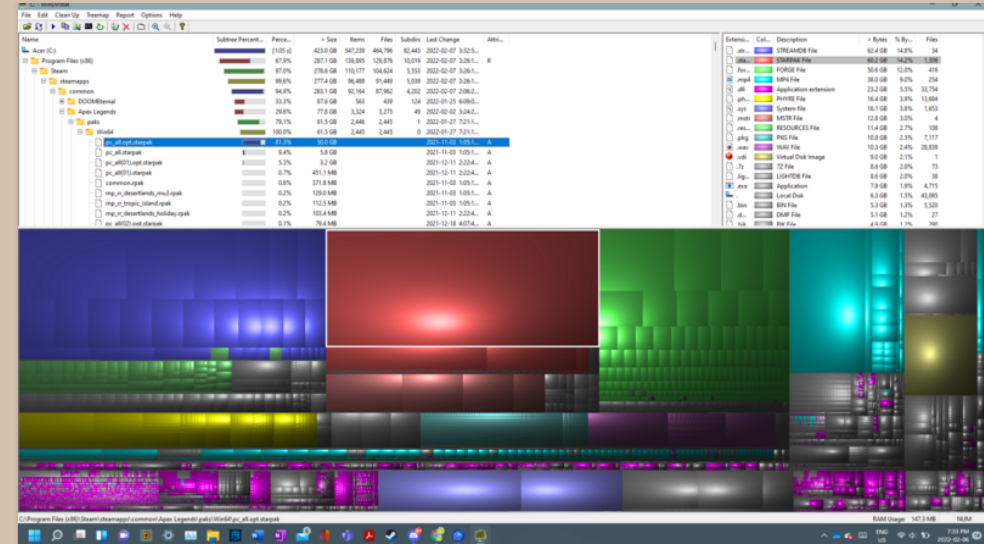
A Cool Online Discovery
