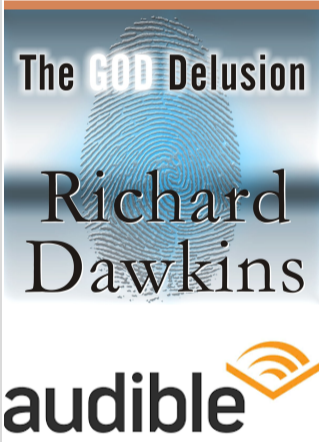


**A symbolic object that represents a significant aspect of your identity.**
