In indigenous culture, animal imagery is often used to explain values, and share stories



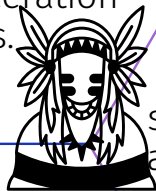
Raven symbolizes change or transformation, sometimes viewed as a trickster because of its ability to change.
