



## Sounds the Same

Assonance is the repetition of vowel sounds in a line of poetry. The following line contains an example of assonance:

i paid my way on the plane to Maine.

The long a sound is repeated in the words paid, way, plane, and Maine.

*Consonance* is the repetition of consonant sounds in a line of poetry. The line below contains consonance, in which the *b* and *ck* consonant sounds are repeated.
