What do you see?

People in ancient civilizations saw patterns in the stars. They named these pictures after animals or gods/goddesses from their legends. Stories abound to describe how the person creature ended up in the stars. Your assignment is to pretend the dots on the ~~back~~ page are stars and see what patterns/constellations you can see. (I'll show you some examples.) Then you are to entertain me with a story about how this object ended up in the stars.

Marking Guide:

- **Picture**
 - Used at least half the dots
 - Fleshed out the image(s) – not just lines
 - Coloured it
- **Story**
 - Between 200-300 words (1 typed page, Word has a word count in Tools)
 - Grammar and spelling
 - Creatively explains how constellation was formed/ended up in the sky (story flows)

Total Possible Marks: Each bullet is worth 5 marks for a total of 30 marks.
