Doerr was born in Cleveland, Ohio in the year 1973


His book "All The Light You Cannot See" won the 2015

He has won five O. Henry Prizes, an award given to short stories of exceptional merit

Doerr has worked and lived in Africa and New Zealand, which is why many of his stories take place in those locations
